The fund manager invests in selected US and Canadian shares, taking into account economic forecasts, profitability and growth prospects of individual companies and industries. This stock fund, figuratively speaking, represents North America in a nutshell – by its practical nature, organizational skills, and dynamic ambition. The power of the world's largest economy is also reflected in the position of global companies domiciled in the US as well as in the selected brands that were born here and today belong to the world's largest. Of course, the strength of the economy is also reflected in the strength of currency. In order to fully participate in the development of economies, the fund does not hedge the currency risk arising from investments in US and Canadian dollar assets. Thus, the movement of both currencies against the Czech koruna is fully reflected in the fund's performance.

Further information about the fund

- It is designed for investors who are looking for the possibility of high appreciation and who are familiar with the risks of stock markets.
- The fund invests at least 75% of its assets in US and Canadian shares with high market capitalization. Unlike global equity funds, there is a higher risk that ensues from focusing on the North American region and the US and Canadian dollar.
- The fund does not secure currency risk. The development of the fund's value is thus influenced not only by the development of share prices but also by fluctuations in exchange rates.
- Investment in the fund can only be recommended with a long-term investment horizon (8 years or more).

How to start?
